Mahindra International School (Formerly Mercedes-Benz International School) was founded as a not for profit in 1998 to serve the needs of a growing expatriate community and internationally minded Indian citizens in a fast-developing Info Tech Park on the outskirts of Pune, Maharashtra. Mahindra International School is accessible by a 3-hour expressway drive from Mumbai or via a small international airport in Pune.

THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Mahindra International School is academically non-selective, co-educational, and richly diverse in students and faculty. 40 nationalities are represented with an expatriate population of 70%. English is the medium of instruction. Student enrollment is stable with 360 students, preschool through IB Diploma, with a waiting list for admission. Many of the 65 teachers hold advanced degrees and are internationally active as IB Examiners, IB Workshop Leaders, and Evaluation/Accreditation visiting team members for NEASC, CIS and the IBO.

Mahindra International School operates on a semester calendar of 187 instructional days. Semester 1 runs early August to mid-December. Semester 2 runs early January to mid-June. DP classes have 4 blocks of 85-minutes each day.
