Mahindra International School is a not-for-profit institution founded in 1998 to serve the needs of a growing expatriate community and internationally-minded Indian citizens. Formerly named Mercedes-Benz International School, the campus is in a fast-developing Info Tech Park on the outskirts of Pune in Maharashtra state. Mahindra International School is accessible by a 3-hour expressway drive from Mumbai or via a small international airport in Pune.

THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Mahindra International School is academically non-selective, co-educational, and richly diverse in students and faculty. About 30 nationalities are represented with an expatriate population of 70%. English is the medium of instruction. Student enrollment is approximately 300 students, preschool through IB Diploma. Many of the 65 teachers hold advanced degrees and are internationally active as IB Examiners, IB Workshop Leaders, and Evaluation/Accreditation visiting team members for NEASC, CIS and the IBO.

CALENDAR

Mahindra International School operates on a semester calendar of 187 instructional days. Semester 1 runs early August to mid-December. Semester 2 runs early January to mid-June. DP classes have 4 blocks of 85-minutes each day.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC

MIS moved fully to online learning in March of 2020. Synchronous student instruction, assessment, and grading to the same standards as expected by the IB and our own curriculum have continued. It is unknown when or if students will be permitted back on campus this academic year by the government and education department. All SAT, ACT and standardized tests have been repeatedly cancelled since December 2019. It is unknown if testing will resume this year.

GRADES, REPORTING AND TEST SCORES

MIS does not rank nor report individual student GPA on transcripts. Disciplinary action resulting in student off-campus suspension during the last two years, incidents of academic integrity, or any change in student MIS enrollment status is disclosed according to university expectations either pre or post admission. Continuous 2-year assessment and grading without averaging is reported and aligned with the IB to allow consistent and reliable prediction of final IB grades. Each transcript grade is based on assessment evidence aligned with the IB to offer a current prediction:

7=Excellent 6=Very Good 5=Good 4=Satisfactory 3=Mediocre 2=Poor 1=Minimal
