¹ Scholarships amounts shown are those for merit and the total awarded for duration of education subject to conditions. Need based financial aid is not shown and not all scholarship amounts may have been fully reported by the student with accompanying evidence. Many universities recognize the higher grades earned by students in their IB examinations to be equivalent to university level courses and after enrollment give significant amounts of college course credit for these grades. These credits may allow a student to enter directly into the second year of university and result in significant financial savings or allow a student to earn an additional degree in the same amount of time as a single degree.

² Many US Universities and Colleges, as well as a selection of others around the world, do not admit or allow students to enroll into a preferred field of study. They require students to hold off on degree and career decisions until later. These institutions value the gained maturity and independence of being away from home to build better perspective from a broad set of interests and university courses which could not be understood by a high school student. This broad-based and open-minded approach is similar to the philosophy of the IB and continues to promote the agility that comes with life-long learning. This first two years tend to focus on the core courses of a Liberal Arts and Science program of study that gives the broader critical thinking and preparation valued by the professional workplace and graduate school admissions.

³ ED = Early Decision which is a binding agreement that if accepted, the student will withdraw all other applications and enroll in this first-choice school. This reduces the number of later acceptances that would have been received by these students who typically would have also received favorable offers from their other highly selective universities.

⁴ Korean University Acceptance data is incomplete as applications and acceptances occur after students have graduated and it is difficult to get this information. In addition, students who are required for national service may delay their university plans until afterwards.

⁵ Next Genius scholarships are earned by students studying in India who take a competitive reasoning examination and selection by a partner university through an interview process.
