<sup>1</sup>ED = Early Decision which is a binding agreement between a student and university that if accepted the student will withdraw all other applications and enroll in this first-choice school. This reduces the number of additional acceptances that would have also been received by this student later in the year.

<sup>2</sup>Many US Universities and Colleges, as well as a selection of others around the world, do not admit or allow students to enroll into a preferred field of study. They require students to hold off on degree and career decisions until later in their first or second year of university. These institutions value the gained maturity and independence of being away from home to build a better perspective from a broad set of interests and university courses which could not be understood by a high school student. This broad-based and open-minded approach is similar to the philosophy of the IB and continues to promote the agility that comes with life-long learning. This first two years tend to focus on the core courses of a Liberal Arts and Science program of study that gives the broader critical thinking and preparation valued by the professional workplace and graduate school admissions.

<sup>3</sup>✓f=Firmly accepted. ✓i=Insurance. Applications to universities in the UK are given a conditional offer that a student must achieve to be admitted. Once a student has received their offers, they accept two of the offers, one as “firm” which means they will attend if the condition is made and the other as “insurance” with a lower offer in case the firm offer is not achieved.
