

College and University Acceptances, Offers and Plans in 2019

MBIS students are encouraged to carefully research their universities and carefully submit quality applications to fewer than 10 Institutions. On average MBIS students submit 4 applications for admission.

The MBIS class of 2019 was made up of 26 graduates who slightly surpassed the previous year results to earn the highest IB results ever at MBIS. One student earned IB Course Certificates, 25 students earned the Full IB Diploma. Five students (28%) earned the prestigious Bi-lingual IB Diploma through Literature courses in Danish, French, German, and Korean in addition to English Literature. The highest IB points earned were 43 and four students (16%) earned over 40 points. The average IB points earned by IB Diploma earners was 34 and well above the IB World Average of 30. The average IB grade was 5.31 in comparison to the IB World Average of 4.8. Two graduates elected to take a gap year before pursuing further studies to 1-Intern at a company in China and 2-Gain work experience in the UK as well as pursue interests in Photography. Both are applying for university in the following year by using their demonstrated interests with experiential learning to their advantage. The breadth of academic programs into which our students have applied and been accepted is laudable. To preserve a breadth and depth of learning, many Liberal Arts and Science colleges do not permit students to enroll into a particular area of study until at least the conclusion of the first year. Where given, the indicated area of study in parenthesis for liberal arts colleges will change for many of the students after they have better understood their options and demonstrated interest in their first year of university study. The data below includes two students from 2018 who applied this year after a gap year.
